#### **Shiraz, The Y Series, Yalumba, Australia, 2018**

Fragrant notes of violet and sandalwood add aromatic interest to the core of blackberry, blood orange and maraschino cherry flavors, with fresh acidity and muscular tannins in the background.

#### **Tempranillo, El Coto Crianza, Rioja, Spain, 2016**

Plum and berry aromas are a bit rubbery in front of a smacking palate that's tight and racy. Red plum, currant and tomato flavors finish tight, with nothing loose or...

#### **Malbec, Saurus Select, Argentina, 2018**

Complex aromas of sweet and sour cherry as well as vanilla and caramel from the oak ageing. Soft on the palate, fresh and fruity

Tasting notes of black pepper, blackberry, cherry, tomato leaf

#### **Rose, Summer Water, California, 2019**

Tasting notes of orange peel, pink grapefruit, strawberry, watermelon.

#### **Sauvignon Blanc, White's Bay, Marlborough, NZ, 2019**

Green tomato, pineapple and grapefruit notes with an attractive, silky texture.

Inviting aromas of honeysuckle, peach and lychee nut. The mouth feel is of integrated and rich fruit. All with a zesty and clean acidity.

#### **Pinot Noir, Bogle Vintage, California, 2018**

Flavors of sweet red fruits – strawberry and raspberry with notes of oak, vanilla and tobacco.

aromas of blueberry, cassis and cigar box. Juicy flavors like blackberry and plum are accentuated by tobacco leaf before the long and satisfying finish. 40% Syrah, 40% Merlot, 20% Cabernet...

#### **Montepulciano Abruzzo, Italy, 2016**

Notes of cocoa, rhubarb, blackberry and herbs, it has a classic, slightly lush mouthfeel.

#### **Moscato, Stemmari, Italy, 2019**

Perfumes of white flowers with smooth citrus notes. Every sip conveys extreme fruitiness balanced by a pleasant crispness.

#### **Chardonnay, Poppy, Santa Lucia Highlands, CA, 2017**

Starts out with ripe melon and citrus fruit, followed by a lush, creamy texture on the mid palate and slight acidity on the finish.

#### **Mistinguet Cava Brut Sparkling Wine, Spain**

Aromas of meyer lemon and celery leaf with a finely carbonated, dry-yet-fruity light-to-medium body and a short lemon curd, key lime, and sidewalk chalk finish.
